The exhibition will commence with an opening event on Friday, July 12th, starting at 5:30 PM at Gallery Cosmosis, located at 22 Brigantine St, Byron Bay. The evening promises live music, local brews, and delectable finger foods, providing a vibrant backdrop to the diverse showcase of artworks and the ensuing art auction.

Over 50 local artists, including Space Cowboy, Daniel Hand, Jay Manby, Sharon Shostak, Howie Cooke, Naomi Gittoes, Yao Mikami, Mark Cora and many more, have generously contributed to the exhibition. Their artworks span a range of mediums from captivating watercolors to intricate sculptures.
